ADDENDUM TO AVSEC CIRCULAR NO. 18/2006

Subject: Enhancement of admissible limit of Hand Sanitizer to be carried in Cabin Baggage; reg.

In exercise of powers conferred by Section 5A of the Aircraft Act. 1934 (XXII of 1934), read with rule 3 (b) of the Aircraft (Security) Rules, 2011, Director General, Bureau of Civil Aviation Security, for the purpose of the safety and security of passengers, crew, ground personnel and the general public in all matters relating to safeguarding against acts of unlawful interference with civil aviation, it is hereby directed that:

- Due to the spread of Coronavirus infection, passengers are being advised to use Hand Sanitizer frequently. Therefore, it has been decided that passengers boarding an aircraft will be allowed to carry in his/her hand baggage or on his/her person liquid Hand Sanitizer upto 350 ml.
- Aircraft Operators will provide wide publicity to the above instructions and advise passengers to declare at the security check points items carried in conformity with instructions at (2) above.
- Existing instructions, already in force as per BCAS AvSec Circular 18/2006, restricting the carriage of other Liquid items/ gels/pastes or items of similar consistency will continue to be 100 ml.
- The above instructions shall be implemented with immediate effect. This order is valid for three months from the date of issue.
- This issues with the approval of Director General, BCAS.
